- Enacts a cap on greenhouse gas emissions for the year 2020 that is at least 25 percent below 1990 levels and a cap for the year 2050 that is 80-95 percent below 1990 emissions. The best available science indicates these reductions will be needed to stop the damage from getting worse.*
- Assists poor people in developing countries who are already struggling to deal with climate change by providing funding to help them adapt. With this funding, vulnerable communities can diversify their ways of earning a living, and plan and budget for disasters.*
- Assists developing countries to reduce their own emissions through clean energy technologies.*
- Establishes policies to ensure that those who produce greenhouse gases will contribute to help the poor deal with the effects of climate change both here and abroad.*
